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4:1-5 A Charge to Timothy

 - **Read 4:3-4**. How do you see these characteristics happening today?

 - What is required for someone to be able to say, “I have kept the faith.”
 - How do you think Paul knew that his race was finished?

- Why should Christians expect opposition to the message of the cross?
 - What do you learn about Paul’s attitude toward opposition from these verses?
 - How does Paul express his confidence in the Lord in these verses?
