## The Church in Philadelphia:7-13

- In verse 7 how does Jesus identify Himself to the Church in Philadelphia?
- What message do you think Jesus is conveying by His identification to this church?
- How does Jesus commend this church?
- What does the Lord mean by the words, "I have set before you an open door, which no one is able to shut."?
- What promises are made to this church in this letter?
- What do you think Jesus means by "the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world"?

## The Church in Laodicea:14-22

- In verse 14 how does Jesus identify Himself to the Church in Laodicea?
- What do you think Jesus intended to convey to this church by calling Himself "the faithful and true witness"?

- What is the overall message that Jesus had for this church?
- What do you think Jesus means by telling them, "I will spit you out of my mouth"?
- Does it sound to you from reading this letter that this church was no longer being given a chance, or do you see an opportunity for them to change?
- What does this letter tell you about the character of God?
- What counsel does Jesus give in verse 18?
- What promises are made in verses 20 and 21?
- What do you think Jesus means by the familiar ending, "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."?
