- In **verse 24** the Jewish Religious Leaders asked Jesus to tell them plainly if He was the Messiah? Jesus said that He had already sufficiently communicated His identity to them. How did Jesus do that? (See **verse 25**)
- In verse 27 what is one of the characteristics of those who follow Jesus?
- Verses 28 and 29 contain promises. Identify them.
- In verse 30 Jesus makes a claim concerning His essence and nature. What is the conclusion we must make concerning this statement?
- What conclusion did the Jewish Religious Leaders come to? (See verse 33)
- What objection did the Jewish Religious Leaders have to Jesus referring to Himself as "the Son of God"? Why would using that title be considered blasphemy?
- In **verse 37** Jesus spoke of the miracles He had performed as "the works of my Father." Why do you think Jesus spoke of them that way and what did His miracles show the people about the Father?
- Verses 37 and 38 what is Jesus challenging the unbelieving Jews to do?
- Why was Jesus able to repeatedly escape arrest?
- In **verse 40** the people said of John the Baptist, "**John did no sign**." What did they mean by that?
- What was the result of people seeing the signs Jesus performed and believing what John the Baptist had said about Jesus? (Verse 42)
- What do you feel was the most important aspect of this study?
