- What is the sin that the Holy will bring a conviction of guilt about?
- What will the Holy Spirit convict the world of guilt about concerning righteousness?
- What area of judgment will the Holy Spirit bring a conviction of guilt to the world?
- What benefit does the coming of the Holy Spirit give over and above the physical presence of Jesus among His disciples?
- In **verses 12-14** what work of the Holy Spirit does Jesus say He will perform among believers?
- How do you see the Holy Spirit still working among believers?
