- In **verse 53** and following, Jesus uses very graphic and shocking words to describe what we must do as a response of faith. Why do you think He used such words knowing they would be taken as offensive?
- What is the real meaning of eating His flesh and drinking His blood in terms of what we must do in response to His work on the cross?
- Why do you think Jesus used figurative language when it probably would have been easier to just communicate His meaning without figures of speech?
- Why did Jesus ask the question, "Do you want to go away as well?" in verse 67?
- What does Peter's response in verse 68 communicate to you about Peter's attitude toward Jesus?
- If Jesus knew that Judas was "a devil" and would betray Him (verse 70-71) why did He select Judas?
- What did this study teach you about the character of Jesus?
- What truths from this passage did the Holy Spirit minister to your heart?
