- Why do you think the response of the religious leaders walking away began with the oldest first?
- What question did Jesus ask the woman after her accusers left?
- In **verse 11**, how would you describe the balance between compassion and confrontation that Jesus showed the woman?
- Why do you think that same balance is so difficult for Christians to maintain?
- What would be the result if we only expressed compassion without confrontation?
- What would be the result if we only expressed confrontation without compassion?
- How are the remarks that Jesus made to this woman consistent with his mission as Savior?
- Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-3 and explain how those verses apply to this story.
