- Read verses 11 and 13. How does the world react to the two witnesses coming back to life and being taken up to heaven for all to see?
- What is the result of the earthquake that shakes Jerusalem?
- Chapter 11 ends with rejoicing in heaven. Why is that?
- What was the most important element you learned from this study?
